



Elephant Peace Sanctuary Nepal Volunteer Program Application Form

Namaskar and Welcome to our Elephant Peace Sanctuary Nepal Volunteer Program at Association Moey. Here we provide sanctuary to our 2 retired elephants Lucky Kali and Begam Kali. The goal of our program is to invite committed volunteers to join us in supporting our elephants' welfare through activities like gardening, food harvesting and preparation, maintaining the enclosures and sanctuary facilities, and promoting awareness about elephant welfare. The volunteer's labor and program fees go directly towards ensuring that our two elephants enjoy their remaining lives in the sanctuary.

A typical day of our volunteers blends elephant husbandry and sanctuary maintenance so that our elephants can focus on being elephants in our sanctuary. We are seeking volunteers who are committed to our mission of providing choice and space for our elephants, have a deep appreciation and respect for elephants, are not afraid to get dirty and work hard, enjoy working as a team, and have strong skills and/or interest in creating social media content, have construction experience, enjoy creating dynamic ideas for fundraising and marketing, and/or have wildlife backgrounds. However, we welcome all people who share our passion for elephants because we know everyone has something to contribute!

This position requires physical strength and stamina in high temperatures therefore applicants should be in excellent physical health. The applicant should also be comfortable living in basic accommodations and be flexible with unpredictable changes. This is Nepal after all! The weekly fee is \$400 USD, with a 2 week minimum time commitment, with a preference for volunteers wanting to stay longer. This is so that the volunteer can be a solid and self-sufficient member of the elephant team. You will also find the volunteer experience more meaningful with longer stays. If we work well together, there is no maximum time commitment.
